

Services

The term “supervised visitation” is used to describe two basic types of services:

1. Supervision of an entire visit between a child and a non-custodial relative; and
2. Supervision or monitoring of the transfer of the child from one parent to another.

A Safe Place’s Supervised Visitation Center provides both of these services for families in a safe and comfortable setting as well as parenting support for both parents.

Visitation Fees

Visitation Fees are determined using a sliding fee scale. Both parents/guardians are required to complete an on-site intake prior to any scheduled visits.

Program Philosophy

Parents have a shared responsibility for their children. Most often children benefit from having regular contact with both parents regardless of the parents' relationship. Supervised Visitation and Exchange services are organized around the safety and wellbeing of the child(ren). These services allow them to maintain a relationship with the non-custodial parent while attempting to isolate them from the conflict between parents.

Safety and Security

The Visitation Center is dedicated to ensuring the safety of everyone using the Center and, therefore, has the following safety measures in place:

- On-site security officers.
- Staggered arrival and departure times for custodial and non-custodial parents to prevent any contact between the two.
- Separate parking areas and entrances.
- Participants sign an agreement to adhere to all program guidelines and policies.
- The Center reserves the right to check any bags or purses brought into the visit.
- The Center may refuse or terminate services to families if it is deemed that visitation/exchanges cannot be done in a safe manner.
