September 2023 TAFDC Clothing Allowance is \$450 per child. Apply now!



What is the clothing allowance?

The Department of Transitional Assistance (DTA) pays the clothing allowance for eligible children in late August or September. The payment is \$450 for each child in the family getting TAFDC (welfare) cash assistance.



Can my family get the clothing allowance?



If you already get TAFDC, you do not need to do anything to get the clothing allowance. DTA will deposit \$450 on or close to August 30 for each child already getting TAFDC.

You may qualify for the clothing allowance even if your income was too high to get TAFDC before.

TAFDC income limits go up for the month of September.
