



## Supervised Visitation Program

### Visitation Program:

We are dedicated to providing a safe neutral environment where parents and children can spend quality time together. Our goal is to facilitate the visitation process to help families get the most out of this special time together.

### Facility:

The program utilizes space at the Council of Social Concern, located at 2 Merrimac Street, in Woburn. There are child-friendly rooms equipped with age appropriate toys and games that allow for quality parent/child interaction. One of the rooms includes an audio and visual monitoring system. The facility is a safe secured building with handicap access. We are located in a safe populated neighborhood close to bus and train lines.

### Intake Process:

Interviews are required for all parents/caretakers (guardians/custodial/non-custodial). All interviews are scheduled separately and are conducted at the Council of Social Concern.

### Services Provided:

On-site supervised visits are provided every other Saturday, typically of 1.5 hours duration, plus child transfer times of 15 minutes before and after visitations. Visits during the weekday evenings may be offered upon request. Educational supervision is offered upon request.

### FEES:

Intake Fee: one time total charge of \$100

Supervised Visits: \$50 an hour, including transfer time (\$75 for 1½ hour Visit)
